

Ponca City Rifle & Pistol Club, Inc.

RANGE RULES

1. The Ponca City Rifle and Pistol Club Range is restricted to Members' use only. Members are allowed to bring guests. Members are responsible for all guest(s) that they invite. All guests must be accompanied at all times by the member that invited the guest(s).
2. Consumption of and/or being under the influence of alcoholic beverages and/or controlled substances by members or guests while using the range is STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
3. Any trespassers should be reported to the Sheriff at (580)362-2517 and a Club officer.
4. Any emergencies should be reported to 911 and a Club officer.
5. Actions of uncased firearms shall be kept open and chamber empty and magazine removed except when on firing line ready to fire. Keep muzzle pointed in a safe direction. In addition, pistols may be holstered, with magazine removed and all chamber(s) empty.
6. Firing shall only occur on designated ranges into designated backstops, or, in the case of the shotgun range, into designated fall zones.
7. All targets are to be placed at a height to ensure that the bullets impact the berm no more than seven feet high and no lower than two feet high.
8. Everyone on the range must be behind the firing line before firearms are handled, actions are closed, or firing begins.
9. No shooter shall go down range until all shooters have cleared their firearms. Each shooter on the line will indicate that his or her firearm(s) are clear and open and that the shooter has ceased handling the firearm(s) or that the firearm(s) are in a closed and latched case. **No one will handle uncased firearm(s) while anyone is down range.**
10. The first shooter to commence firing will indicate such to the other shooters before firing, unless a Range Officer is in charge.
11. All firing should be directed at a target directly in front of the shooter's firing position.
12. All shooters on a given range must shoot from a common firing line. **At no time should there be any shooting from a firing point in front of or behind any other shooter or group of shooters!**
13. Firearms of unknown sight adjustment shall be test fired at a distance no greater than 25 yards **from the backstop**. When sights are correct, shooter may then move back to the desired distance.
14. The shooter must be able to see his or her target through the sights when firing.
15. Eye and ear protection are **required** for all minors and guests on or near the firing line while firing is in progress.
16. Vehicles are not allowed on the range, except for authorized range maintenance or a scheduled event requiring vehicle use. Drive only on the designated roads and parking areas provided.
17. Scheduled matches or other organized activities shall be open to the general public.
18. A shooter shall use the range that is appropriate to the distance that he or she is shooting.
19. Any range(s) that is scheduled for a match event will be considered reserved for up to 1½ hours prior to said event. The Match Director will release the range(s) for regular use after the finish of the scheduled event.
20. No hunting will occur anywhere on Ponca City Rifle and Pistol Club facilities without prior written permission from the Ponca City Rifle and Pistol Club.
21. Suitable targets must be used. Glass targets are prohibited.
22. When Club target frames are used, targets shall be placed on the backboard that is secured to the target frame. Place targets so that bullets will never strike the frame. Avoid using more than four targets centers per backboard. Anyone caught intentionally damaging the target frames (including by putting excessive target centers on the frame) will forfeit his or her membership without refund.
23. Target frames and unused club targets are to be returned to the storage provided. The target shed is to be locked and the combination on the lock shall be scrambled when the shooter is finished. Ensure all club equipment is secured.
24. Shooters shall pick up all of their center-fire cartridge cases and deposit them in the receptacles provided or take them with them.
25. Targets will not be placed in front of, or on side berms, except for club sanctioned events.
26. When anyone is down range, the shotgun range is closed. For example, oil field workers, farmers, etc.
27. No slugs or buckshot on the shotgun range.
28. Raise the flag(s) on the range you are using during the time that said range is in use. Lower and store flags when that range is no longer in use.
29. Matches may have additional rules.
